Learn how to sketch clothes and draperies

This workshop has been conceived for those students who wish to improve their abilities in drawing and painting any kind of **clothing** and **garments**. During this intensive 30-hour seminar students will learn how to:

- practice drawing of croquis so as to perfect their ability to create a variety of poses.
- sketch costumes from figures and croquis;
- draw the details of dresses, skirts, blouses, accessories, adding color and other details;
- study the effect of light and shadow on draperies as well as on fabric folds and jewelry;
- draw and paint clad models wearing both elegant dresses and historic costumes.

Students can choose to work with various media, such as pencil, charcoal, soft pastels and acrylic colors.

Dressed models will be available each day throughout the workshop.



Cityscape and architecture



How to draw and paint an urban area

This course is designed to provide the student with an opportunity to gain or enhance abilities in drawing or sketching cityscapes and townscapes (or any architectural elements or skylines) without using measuring tools or guides to assist in the artwork.

During this workshop students will develop their "free-hand" drawing skills by relying exclusively on their hand-eye coordination. They will learn to create an artistic representation of the physical aspects of a city or a town. Lessons will take place both in our Art studio and outside in the streets and squares of Florence, so that students can experiment with a hands-on approach of the subject through a direct observation of the buildings and monuments around them.

Besides drawing with pencils or charcoals students can also opt for other media, such as watercolors, oil and acrylic colors. In this case their practice will focus especially on the use of colors and on the creation of shades.

This course is ideal for those students who need to get trained with the freehand drawing as well as with the perspective sketching of squares and of streets.
