

Drawing and Painting techniques



Art from 1 week to 9 months

The complete course in Art is divided into **9 units** (from unit A to unit I) and lasts 9 months. Students are however welcome to attend specific parts of the course (minimum 1 week). Courses normally **start on any Monday**.

The teachers, highly qualified and experts in the various disciplines and techniques such as classical drawing, oil painting, watercolour and fresco, will evaluate the students' skills at the beginning of each unit and help them to establish their objectives. Each unit lasts 4 weeks, for a total amount of 56 or 80 hours, inclusive of **8 hours of living models**.

The first units introduce **basic drawing and painting techniques** while the following units aim at **developing and improving students artistic skills**. At the end of these nine units students will have acquired the basic knowledge required towards the making of their **personal portfolios** and will concentrate on the study of one specific technique.

The lessons are integrated with conversations on art history and guided visits to the most important monuments in Florence. In order to ensure the highest quality of tuition, the number of students will not exceed 10 per group.

At the end of these nine units students will have acquired the basic knowledge required towards the making of their personal portfolios and concentrate on the study of one specific technique.

Two or three Art exhibitions a year will be organized for the students attending Art course.

- Intensive Art courses (**20 hours per week**) take place from 11.30am to 1pm and from 1.30pm to 5pm, Monday through Thursday.

- General Art courses (**14 hours per week**) take place either in the **morning** (10am-1pm Monday-Thursday and 10am-12pm on Friday) or in the **afternoon** (1.30pm-5pm, Monday-Thursday) or in the evening (5.15pm-8.45pm Monday-Thursday).
